- 1 For the Body of Christ to be touched by the heart of God for the prisoner.
- 2 For healing of emotional and psychological wounds; for those struggling with fear, anger, depression, anxiety, and suicidal thoughts .
- 3 For inmates to encounter the true love of God, and receive Christ as Lord and Savior.
- 4 For spouses parted by prison walls to be faithful and persevere in trials.
- 5 For the Holy Spirit to raise up men & women of God to serve on the prison mission field.
- 6 For access to illicit drugs and alcohol inside to be shut down.
- 7 For women inmates and the particular temptations and struggles they face.
- 8 For God to raise up youth ministers to volunteer in juvenile facilities.
- 9 For discipleship ministries to MULTIPLY in prison. Inmates need Christian training!
- 10 For the inmate's child to receive care & support through children's ministry & pastoral care.
- 11 For Christ to heal the life-long pain of rejection and hopelessness so many addicts face.
- 12 For youth offenders get real help, and not be marginalized or stereotyped their whole life.
- 13 For inmate's children to be protected from their parent's sin, addiction, and crime. For them to see justice for crimes committed against them.
- 14 For the Spirit of God to move upon men and women and stop the rampant violence inside.
- 15 For inmates to learn how to study the Word of God and have access to study materials.
- 16 For inmates to connect to an aftercare ministry and church *before* their release.
- 17 For chaplains & volunteers to have favor with facility administrators, staff, & security officers.
- 18 For protection from illness chapel volunteers, inmates, and correctional staff.
- 19 For The Church to welcome post-release men & women with love, acceptance & forgiveness.
- 20 For a just legal system: speedy court dates and honest public defenders.
- 21 For sex offenders to receive the ministry and therapy they need, as well as jobs and housing.
- 22 For families of prison ministers to endure well the sacrifices ministry requires.
- 23 For the loved ones of the incarcerated left to pick up the pieces and keep it all together.
- 24 For families to be restored, marriages repaired, and parents reunited with their children.
- 25 For inmates to be delivered from a spirit of hopelessness and death. This is so important.
- 26 **PRISON MINISTRY SUNDAY:** For chaplains to as they face increasing darkness inside; for them to walk in spiritual authority and anointing; for them to receive ministry and pastoral care, too.
- 27 For former inmates to find home churches where they can grow in Christ and serve God.
- 28 For the prison ministers to be above reproach, but also PROTECTED from false accusations. .
- 29 For the Lord to raise up aftercare leaders and Titus 2 Brothers and Sisters.
